

## Tips for Family Engagement

1. Get to know family members to make them feel a part of your program.
2. Use formal and informal communication to connect with the families you serve.
3. Let families know they are welcome at your program.
4. Honor family diversity by translating materials for non-English speaking families. Have events that celebrate all cultures. Hire staff who reflect the families you serve.
5. Offer activities where caregivers learn new skills.
6. Offer enjoyable learning experiences where the whole family can learn together.
7. Invite caregivers to play a role in program decision making or lead activities.
8. Connect families to schools and services available in the community.
